# **Cookie Drive Thru**

Cookies will be here this week! If you are participating in one of our Cookie Drive Thru locations, be sure to come prepared. We have tips to help ensure you are ready!

#### Helpful Tips & Tricks

- 1. Be prepared for the weather. If you are picking up cookies in an open bed truck, please bring a tarp to protect the cookie boxes from rain.
- 2. Clean out your vehicle ahead of time to maximize the space for carrying cookies
- 3. Please be prepared to wait in your vehicle until you enter the count/sort selection.

4. If multiple vehicles are picking up for your troop, please pull over and wait for all vehicles to arrive prior to getting in the drive-thru line.

Wondering if you need multiple cars? Check out the chart below to help decide.



# **Picking Up Your Cookies**

The majority of troops will participate in one of our cookie drive-thrus. Both the pickup location and time can be chosen in Smart Cookies after placing the initial order.

# **Cookie Cupboards**

Our Cookie Cupboards will open the week of February 22nd! In order for us to have your cookies ready and guaranteed when you pick up, we use a planned order system in Smart Cookies. Planned orders placed in Smart Cookies by 11:30 p.m. on Sunday evening will be available for pick up Friday or Saturday.

Here's how to place your planned order:

- 1. Log in to Smart Cookies
- 2. On your dashboard, click on "Orders"
- 3. Click on "Planned Orders"
- 4. Choose the location you want to pick up
- 5. Choose the date and time frame for pickup
- 6. Enter the cookie order
- 7. Click "Save"

Please Note: Planned orders are only for full cases of cookies.

## **Troop Link on the Cookie Locator App**

If your troop is interested in having your link for direct ship appear in the Cookie Locator App, your troop will need to opt in. The GSUSA Troop Link will go live on Friday, February 18th. You can do this with these easy steps:

1. Log into Smart Cookies on or after February 18th

- 2. Under your troop dashboard click on "My Troop"
- 3. Click on "Troop Information"
- 4. Scroll down to find the option It will appear just before "Primary Contact for the Troop"
- 5. It will ask "Publish Troop's Direct ship Link to GSUSA?"
- 6. Check yes if you would like your troop's direct link to appear in the Cookie Locator App

#### **First Cookie Payment**

Your troop's first payment for cookies will be drafted from your troop bank account on Wednesday, March 9th . The Smart Cookies system calculates the payment amount by pulling the balance due from your initial order and subtracting the amount of money that was collected electronically from online payments. The balance is split in half for this first payment. Two days prior to the draft, you will receive an email detailing the amount to be drafted. If your troop is unable to accommodate the scheduled draft, please notify the help desk at gshelper@comgirlscouts.org or by calling (804)746-0590 x316 no later than Tuesday, March 8th by 12:00 p.m.

seeking to take their troop tent camping. This course will give leaders hands-on experiences so they can successfully lead girls on outdoor experiences for multiple nights. Girl Scouts has a lot to offer through outdoor adventures and you will gain knowledge and practical training to prepare you to plan and manage overnight camping trips. You will learn a variety of safety techniques for fires, cooking and camps. You will also receive valuable tips for program planning, clean up, kapers and packing. ## **Happy Black History Month**

Black History Month is an annual celebration of achievements and contributions by the African American and Black communities—a time for recognizing their central role in U.S. history. Also known as African American History Month, the event was the brainchild of noted historian Carter G. Woodson, known as the "father of Black history", and other prominent African Americans. February was chosen by Woodson for the originally week-long observance, as it coincides with the birthdates of both former U.S. President Abraham Lincoln and social reformer Frederick Douglass. Both men played a significant role in helping to end slavery. Woodson also understood that members of the Black community already celebrated the births of Douglass and Lincoln and sought to build on existing traditions.

Heritage month celebrations are important in providing the space to teach, learn, and appreciate the cultural richness of the communities they represent within the wider American narrative.
