
We have one additional cupboard located in Prince George not listed in this resource. Please text Ashley Huggie at 804 858-3108 for availability.

having a popular moment. Unfortunately, we can't always predict the amount of each variety of cookie we will need and for this reason we have turned off the PBS on planned orders for next week. As of today, we don't know when more will be available. Depending on the individual cupboard there may be some available for walk in customers.

The **Raspberry Rally** is proving to be a very popular cookie. After a second release, the cookie sold out again but will be available again for direct ship on March 4th and is predicted to sell out quickly. That will be the last release of the cookie this season.





## Cookie Booths: important reminders and exciting updates!

When scheduling your troop's booths, keep in mind guidance from Girl Scouts of the USA. Certain locations may be inappropriate for young girls based on the standards of your local community, may negatively impact the cookie program experience for girls, and/or may negatively impact our brand in your community. For clarity, girls should not sell in or in front of establishments that they themselves cannot legally patronize. For this reason, GSCV does not approve cookie booths at breweries, wineries, dispensaries, and other establishments/events that primarily sell products that girls cannot legally purchase.



Are you scheduling booths on your own for your troop? Remember to enter those in Smart Cookies so they will show up on the Cookie Finder site. Listing them in Smart Cookies enables your troop to use Smart Cookie credit card processing for electronic payments at your booth.

To enter your troop secured booth in Smart Cookies follow the steps below:

- · Log into Smart Cookies
- · Click on Booth at the top of your dashboard
- · Click on Troop Secured Booths
- Enter the location with the complete address
- · Enter the day and time of the booth

Click Save

Each booth will need to be approved by a member of the GSCV staff before it shows on the Cookie Finder site or as a booth in your troop listing. Booths are approved daily.

#### **Cookie Booths Update**

We added more booth opportunities in Smart Cookies.**Troops now are eligible to sign up for 25 council sponsored booths in the Smart Cookies system**. Please remember if you sign up for a booth but then are unable to be there, please release that booth in Smart Cookies so another troop can have that opportunity. To register for one of these booths follow the steps below:

- 1. Log into Smart Cookies
- 2. Click on Booth at the top of your dashboard
- 3. Click on Schedule Booth
- 4. Select a booth out of the available opportunities

### **First Troop Payment**

Your troop's first payment for cookies will be drafted from your troop bank account on Wednesday, March 15th. The Smart Cookies system calculates the payment amount by pulling the balance due from your initial order January 26th and subtracting the amount of money that was collected electronically from online payments. The balance is split in half for



this first payment. Two days prior to the draft, you will receive an email detailing the amount to be drafted. If your troop is unable to accommodate the scheduled draft, please notify the help desk at gshelper@comgirlscouts.org or by calling (804)746-0590 x316 no later than Tuesday, March 14th by 10:00 a.m. If your troop currently doesn't have a Girl Scout bank account, please let us know by emailing the help desk at gshelper@comgirlscouts.org or calling (804)746-0590 x316.


