Cookie Program Update



As we shared with you last week, supply chain and transportation issues delayed our cookie orders. We received notice from our baker that nothing has changed with deliveries. Unfortunately, this means there will be a delay in filling planned cookie orders for March 4th and 5th and now March 11th and 12th. We realize this will disrupt many cookie booths planned for the coming weekend and apologize for the inconvenience. We expect to have all planned orders, *except for the Peanut Butter Sandwich Cookies*, made for the dates of: March 4, 5, 11, 12, 18, and 19 available for pick up

on March 18th and 19th at the cupboard you selected. If your planned order qualified for delivery, we are determining the logistics of that delivery and will communicate details with you.

If your troop had a scheduled booth that you are no longer able to hold, please cancel it in the Smart Cookies system to remove the booth from the Cookie Finder app. If you choose to cancel one or more of your planned orders, please do so in the Smart Cookies system or contact our help desk

As a reminder, we have extended the date of the 2022 Cookie Program to April 15 th. The direct ship discount is also extended to April 15th.




Our 2022 camp season runs from June 6th – August 6th. We are excited to share we are offering generous incentives for both new and returning staff this year!

Training: April 29th-May 1st | 9:00 a.m. Saturday - 1:00 p.m. Sunday (Friday is optional) | Camp Pamunkey Ridge

Time to get outdoors! The Intermediate Camping Course is designed for leaders and troop volunteers seeking to take their troop tent camping. This course will give leaders hands-on experiences so they can successfully lead girls on outdoor experiences for multiple nights. Girl Scouts has a lot to offer through outdoor adventures and you will gain knowledge and practical training to prepare you to plan and manage overnight camping trips. You will learn a variety of safety techniques for fires, cooking and camps. You will also receive valuable tips for program planning, clean up, kapers and packing. Registration closes Friday, April 15th for Intermediate Camping Training.
