If this is your first time experiencing one of our product drive-thru's, these tips will be helpful:

 $\cdot~$ Plan for the weather. If you are bringing a pick-up truck, make sure you can cover the product if it rains.

 \cdot It never hurts to clean out your vehicle ahead of time to ensure you have enough room.

- As much as we love dogs, it might be best to leave yours at home on delivery day.
- · Remember to stay in your vehicle until you get to the count and sort section.

 $\cdot~$ You don't need to bring a list of the product you are picking up, but it's helpful to know your troop number.

Sunday, January 1st	Girls can begin taking orders and selling online
Wednesday, January 25th	Deadline for Troop Leaders to input girl orders in Smart Cookies
February 15th-22nd	Traditional deliveries (rural communities)
Thursday, February 16th	Cookie Drive Through in Fredericksburg
Friday, February 17th	Cookie Drive Through in Richmond
Saturday, February 18th	Cookie Drive Through in Chesterfield
Tuesday, February 21st	Cookie Cupboards open
Wednesday, March 15th	First ACH draft (50% of initial order)
Friday, March 31st	Final day of cupboard operation, last day of program
Tuesday, April 4th	Second ACH draft (balance due) and Reward orders due in Smart Cookies by Troop Leaders
