





Don't forget to pick up your Fall Product to distribute to girls:

- Friday, October 20th, 8:00a.m.- 12:00 pm at Fredericksburg Expo Center
- Saturday, October 21st, 8:00am-12:00pm at Richmond (The Diamond) and Chesterfield (Dunmar Moving and Storage)

Rural deliveries will take place October 23rd-October 24th.

If the troop leader is unavailable to pick up the product, it's fine to send another adult related to the troop to do so. If you encounter an issue and can't pick it up, please let us know and make other arrangements at gshelper@comgirlscouts.org.

If this is your first time experiencing one of our product drive-thrus, these tips will be helpful:

- Plan for the weather. If you are bringing a pick-up truck, make sure you can cover the product if it rains.
- It never hurts to clean out your vehicle ahead of time to ensure you have enough room.
- As much as we love dogs, it might be best to leave yours at home on delivery day.
- Remember to stay in your vehicle until you get to the count and sort

- section.
- You don't need to bring a list of the products you are picking up, but it's helpful to know your troop number.


Tired of cooking the same old meals each time your troop goes camping? Join experienced GSCV Outdoor Trainers for a day of cooking and eating! You will have
