
GSUSA Mental Wellness 101

The GSUSA Mental Wellness 101 course is now available through your gsLearn account. In this course, you will learn what mental health is and how to recognize the signs of mental health challenges. You will explore different scenarios that young people may experience and learn how you can promote an environment within Girl Scouts for you and others to thrive and grow. This course is perfect for troop leaders and other adult volunteers who work directly with Girl Scouts. The course will take approximately 25 minutes and you can go at your own pace.

Training for Daisy & Brownie Leaders

Girl Scouts has emphasized the importance of getting outdoors for the past 110 years. Learning about the environment and having fun outdoors



helps Girl Scouts build courage, confidence and character to make the world a better place. *Growing Up WILD* builds on Girl Scout Daisy's and Brownie's sense of wonder about nature and invites them to explore wildlife. Through a wide range of activities and experiences, explore differences between living and non-living objects, basic needs and characteristics of plants and animals. Leaders will receive a troop copy of the *Growing Up WILD* guide along with other resources to help conduct the activities with their troop. The 27 *Growing Up WILD* activities support many of the Daisy and Brownie badges, including the Outdoor Art, Math in Nature, Camping and more.


